## REGULATION OF DOCTORAL/RESEARCH STAYS INTERDISCIPLINARY CENTER FOR GENDER STUDIES (CIEG)

The doctoral/research stays at the Interdisciplinary Center for Gender Studies (CIEG) are regulated by the Manual of Procedures of the Research Support Office of the Institute of Social and Political Sciences, University of Lisbon (ISCSP-ULisbon).

In addition to the rules and procedures already established by the above mentioned Office, CIEG establishes the following requirements:

- 1. CIEG will host candidates who are attending doctoral programmes or researchers with a PhD.
- 2. Doctoral/research stays at CIEG must have a three-month minimum duration, with a minimum of 10 hours of attendance in person, per week, under the supervision of a CIEG's Integrated Researcher.
- 3. Researchers wishing to complete a research stay at CIEG must commit to submit an article to a national or international scientific journal peer reviewed, in co-authorship with their CIEG's supervisor.
- 4. In addition, PhD students or researchers may produce a working paper, which will be made available on CIEG's website.
- 5. This Regulation shall be signed upon arrival of the student or researcher, as a declaration of commitment and acceptance of the established rules.
- 6. Any situations outside the present regulation will be evaluated by CIEG's Board on a case-by-case basis.
